You don't need the full program in most cases. **The T3, T4, and T7 are the most important services for most trees and shrubs.** Your Tree and Shrub Program could consist of just these 3 important services. For scale and leaf-feeding insect problems on plants, T1 will really help out. Late summer problems with mites, then a T5 will help. For better soil and healthier plants, a T6 would be in order.
